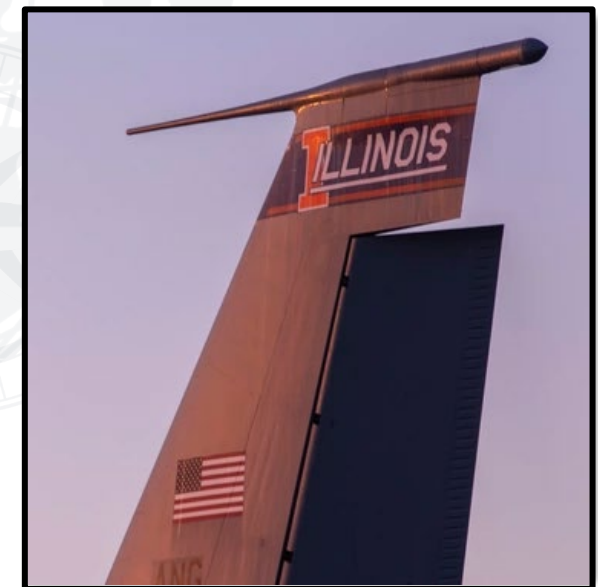

KC-135 Stratotanker

The KC-135 Stratotanker serves as a critical asset for the United States Air Force, excelling in its core role of aerial refueling for over 60 years.

Mission and Role:

- The KC-135 provides aerial refueling capabilities, allowing the Air Force to achieve its primary mission of global reach.
- It also supports air refueling for Navy, Marine Corps, and allied nation aircraft.
- During aeromedical evacuations, the KC-135 can transport litter and ambulatory patients using patient support pallets.



KC-135 Boom Operator

The boom operator is stationed in the rear of the plane and controls the boom during in-flight air refueling. The boom operator lays prone and guides the boom insert into a receptacle on the receiving aircraft.



KC-135 Pilot

Pilots the aircraft and commands crews to accomplish tanker, airlift, training, and other missions. Plans and prepares for missions. Performs, supervises or directs navigation and in-flight refueling.
