

ENLISTED SPECIALTIES:

Aerospace Medical Technician: Job Description: An Aerospace Medical Technician performs technical nursing duties such as immunizations, dialysis blood pressure checks and eye exams. Personnel are certified from the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians (NREMT).



Health Services Management: Job Description: Health Services Management personnel are there to help all

medical staff. Duties include checking in members for appointments, reviewing medical records for accuracy and completeness and keep a seamless stream of communication to help get the members' care.



Public Health Technician:

Job Description: Public Health Technicians aim to prevent the spreading of diseases by conducting patient interviews, investigations and through community outreach programs, oversee medical clearance for personnel who are deploying, conduct audiograms, conduct food and health safety inspections and train individuals on proper techniques to avoid spreading illnesses.





Dental Assistant: Job Description: A dental assistant's main job function is to assist the Dentist in the dental exams, preparing the patient by taking vital signs and prepping dental equipment for the visit. The dental assistant is responsible for reviewing records for accuracy and maintaining patient records in the electronic health record.
